Essentials

Reading Expectations	10 minutes daily: read to an adult or read independently and talk about it with an adult; this should be recorded in Reading Records (by adult or child), books should be in school daily.
Maths Expectations	5 minutes <i>Times Tables Rockstars</i> daily: play on Garage and Studio to develop fluent recall of multiplication tables and gain a Rock Star Status!
Spelling Expectations	If you have been set spellings to learn, please set aside 10 minutes twice a week to do this. If these are all completed then you may choose to practise new spellings from the Year 3 and 4 spelling list which is on the class website page.

Optional Topic Tasks

- Choose a different activity to **do with your family each week**. There is no right or wrong way to complete the task. Take as long, or as little, time as you like; large projects may take a number of weeks.
- When you have completed a Topic Task, share it with us via email, photo or video or bring in a piece of writing, scrap book or artwork and you will be rewarded with house points in recognition of your efforts!

Can you make a non-fiction book about Ancient Egypt? Remember to include facts, use headings/sub-headings, text boxes, bullet points. If you are feeling creative, try to make a pop-up book! <i>English</i>	Can you write a diary entry for Howard Carter? Watch this video to find out about what he did. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zr2tnrd <i>English</i>	Read part of your book then see if you can write some literal and inference questions for someone else to answer. <i>Reading</i>
Roll a dice 6 times to make 2 three digit numbers. Can you add them together using column addition? Remember to estimate your answer first then to check it with an inverse sum. <i>Maths</i>	Can you use a number line to add and subtract? Choose your own numbers, draw your line and think carefully about the 'jumps' you do. <i>Maths</i>	Practise your times tables by listening to one of the times table songs – you can use a search engine to find the one you need to work on. <i>Maths</i>
Can you make a fact file of an Ancient Egyptian Pharaoh or an Ancient Egyptian god? Include facts about them and a picture too. <i>History</i>	Can you create a picture or a model of something to do with our topic? This could be a Pharaoh's mask, a Sarcophagus, a scene from Ancient Egypt, a mummy or anything else you can think of. Try to be creative and have fun! <i>History/Art/DT</i>	Forces Detective! <i>Find 6 examples of forces around your home. Look for pushes, pulls, twists, friction and magnetism. Draw or photograph each one and label the type of force and whether it is contact or non-contact. Example: pushing a door open – a push force, contact force.</i> <i>Science</i>
Make a Christmas card for someone. Can you make it 3D or pop up? <i>Art & DT</i>	Can you make a poster with some of the vocabulary we have learnt so far? Try using it to teach a family member some new French words. <i>French</i>	Find a piece of music you enjoy. What instruments can you hear? What type of music is it? Can you describe the Tempo (fast or slow), Dynamics (loud or quiet) and the Pitch (high or low)? <i>Music</i>
