### Topic Tasks

Please pick a different activity to **do with your family each week**. Completing your homework with your family should be a positive experience, the discussion & fun you have is just as important as the outcome. Enjoy!

There is no right or wrong way to complete the task. Take as long, or as little, time as you like on these tasks. A large project may take a number of weeks.

Bring Topic Tasks to school in any way you like: email, photo, written, scrap book, artwork, edible... You can send any photos that you take to the class teacher or print them out to show the class.

Create a model or draw a diagram of a river and label some of the geographical features <i>Geography</i>	Go for a walk near the river and take photos of any geographical features that you can see <i>Geography</i>	Draw or paint a landscape scene which includes a river <i>Geography/ Art</i>
Explain the properties of solids, liquids and gases <i>Science</i>	Investigate the time it takes for different liquids to freeze and record your results. Think about how to do this scientifically <i>Science</i>	Make something like chocolate crispy cakes where there is a change of state (chocolate melting and then cooling) <i>Science</i>
Write a poem based on a river or the journey of a river <i>English/ Geography</i>	Find out about a place of Christian pilgrimage <i>RE</i>	Think about different emotions that we all experience. How can you help yourself when you have negative emotions? <i>PSHE</i>
Explain what you have been learning in maths. How could you teach someone what you have learnt? <i>Maths</i>	Write and perform a weather forecast script. Ask someone to record you presenting <i>Computing/ Geography</i>	Draw or make your own 2D or 3D map of a fantasy island <i>Art</i>
